(Rom. 3:23)</li> <li>Salvation: Forgiveness and a new life comes to us through Jesus only (John 14:7)</li> <li>Sanctification: The process by which we are made holy and whole.</li> <li>Healing: Jesus' death on the cross was for our spiritual and physical healing.</li> <li>The Church: The gatehred people of God are His method for reaching the world.</li> <li>The Resurrection from the Dead: Jesus is the example of our hope of life after death.</li> <li>The Return of Jesus: Jesus promised to return, bringing God's Kingdom to fulness.</li> <li>Human Sexuality and Marriage: We are created by God, both male and female, and placed in family unitys that reflect God's purposes in creation.</li> </ul>
